Habit-Based Fundraising

- How does the My Coke Rewards for Schools program work?
 My Coke Rewards for Schools enables parents and others in the community to support local schools by donating My Coke Rewards points and/or cash to help schools purchase physical education, sports, technology, art and/or classroom supplies.
- **Box Tops** bring in about \$2000 a year that goes to the teachers (about \$100 per teacher per year).
- ➤ Labels for Education: We have 28,475 points in our account. There are products that we can buy for the school. Arts, athletics and academics are the categories of the merchandise catalog. Keep bringing in those labels.
- > Spartan brand Labels: For every 1000 labels, we get \$20.
- ➤ Ink Cartridges: We get a different amount of money for each cartridge (ranging from .05 \$4)
- *The Paper Gator earns between \$100 \$120 quarterly. Keep bringing in your papers/junk mail/cereal boxes/etc. DROP OFF LOCATIONS at both North Park and Wellerwood.
