

“Cheat Sheet” for Pie Sale 2016



THE PIES

- 2016 pie choices are Apple or Cherry.
- They are NOT gluten-free but they ARE vegan.
- Fruit, equipment and supervision are all from a local farmer.
- The farmer now brings apples already sliced and frozen so we do NOT do the peeling, coring or cutting any more. They also make for even tastier pies!
 - This also means we need less volunteers for Saturday – but we'll still get messy so dress comfy!
- Pies ordered for Charity will all be Apple and will go to a North Park selected charity. We can deliver these pies only.
 - Previous charities have included God's Kitchen, Kid's Food Basket, Senior Meals on Wheels and Gilda's Club.
- Order forms must be turned in to NPM teachers by Wed, February 10 (we need to get a final count to the farmer that weekend!).
- ALL pies not ordered for charity must be picked up on February 20 at CITY High/Middle school by the family who turns in the order. That family is then responsible for getting orders to customers.
 - We are asking that families with orders of over 50 pies pick up between 2pm and 3:30pm (so we have time to get the orders all together for sure).
- All pies have not been baked and will need to be stored in a refrigerator or freezer.
- Baking instructions are included in each box.

ORDERING

- There a link and shopping cart set up for online ordering at the North Park website (northparkschools.org/apple-pie/)
- Order forms have been sent home and are available in Digital Backpack. **Orders and money are due to teachers by Wed., Feb. 10.**

NPM FAMILY PARTICIPATION

- Participation = families completing 2 of the 4 tasks (we need all those things to make it really work).
- ALL children in a family will receive participation "credit" for those things.
- Participation includes ordering pies and/or volunteering on Saturday—making pies, helping fill orders, clean-up crew, or sending in food for volunteers—and/or volunteering to help PTA cover the Extra Recesses earned by classrooms which reach their goals.

INCENTIVES FOR NPM STUDENTS

- Specific pie order totals will be counted for the student (and classroom) designated on the order form(s) submitted and the student designated on online orders.
- Students earn Prize Bucket tickets for orders of 2, 5, 10 and 15 pies or more (can earn up to 4 tickets).
- Prize Buckets will be like a raffle. Students will receive tickets to put in the bucket of their choosing—but do not automatically get a prize.
- There will be a set of prizes for Wellerwood Campus and a set for the North Park Campus. There will only be one Grand Prize Bucket (for lunch with Ms. Sorge).
- Classrooms with sale total of 70 or more pies also receive Extra Recess (does not have to be in winter).
- Classrooms with 100% family participation receive Extra Recess (does not have to be in winter).
